CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHERS

- 1. Teachers shall strive to attain the highest standards of punctuality, honesty & responsible ethical practices.
- 2. The teachers shall be truthful when making statement about their qualifications and competencies.
- 3. The teachers shall contribute to the development of an open and reflective professional culture.
- 4. The teachers shall treat colleagues and associates with respect, & working together in a very congenial environment.
- 5. Teacher should strictly follow the academic policy and instructions of higher authorities.
- 6. Mentoring system/Class teacher system must be effectively implemented.
- 7. Teachers should be good counsellors and Facilitators. They should help, guide, encourage and assist the students to ensure that the Teaching-Learning Process is effective and successful. Value based education must be their motto.
- 8. Teachers should maintain decorum both inside and outside the classroom and set a good example to the students.

- 9. Teachers should carry out other academic, co-curricular and organizational activities that may be assigned to them from time to
- 10. Teachers must avoid physical punishments to students for any reason. However, they can warn such students or report to the Principal for necessary action in case of serious misbehaviour.
- 11. Students violating dress code must not be allowed to attend the lectures, practical labs and Library.
- 12. The teachers must refrain from joining any political party & refrain from making political comments during lectures or discussions with students.
- 13. The teachers must dress decently in formal wears to best suit the dignity of the profession.
- 14. All the faculty members should constructively contribute toward the development of the college and university.
- 15. All the faculty members should make efforts for the continuous development of their professional abilities through training programs, workshops, and research & development activities.
